Scout Sunday is February 4, how are you celebrating it?

BSA was founded on February 8, 1910. Scout Sunday is celebrated the Sunday preceding February 8; if February 8 is a Sunday, Scout Sunday is celebrated on February 8.

Scout Sunday helps raise awareness about Scouting among parishioners and highlights all Scouts' Duty to God. This can be a time to invite others in your parish to become involved in Catholic Scouting, either as families of young children, as older children who want to get involved and as adults who want to volunteer with Catholic Scouting. This is also a great time to honor Scouts and adults for their volunteer activities in service of your parish and your broader community.

Now's the time to engage in the National Eucharistic Revival!

The National Eucharistic Revival is a 3-year initiative sponsored by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. The revival was launched in 2022 and continues until Pentecost in 2025. NCCS encourages all Catholic Scouts to engage in the National Eucharistic Revival in some way.



During the spring and summer of 2024, Catholic Scouts have multiple opportunities to participate in the revival. From May 17 to July 16, 2024, Catholics across the country will be engaged in a Eucharistic Pilgrimage. Local Scouting units are invited to participate on the leg of the pilgrimage that makes sense for them - there are four main routes. Plan now – and find out if Scouts can assist local organizers to make the Eucharistic Pilgrimage a success.

The pilgrimage culminates in a Eucharistic Congress that will take place from July 17-21 at Lucas Oil Stadium in Indianapolis, which all Catholic Scouts and their families are invited to attend.


